

Volunteers from East Valley High School girl's cross country team will be part of this year's event, so let's have a great turnout for this health-inspiring outdoor activity. Plus, after the run join the FRA for huckleberry pancakes in the Community Center. So even if you don't participate in the actual run/walk, you can definitely participate in the breakfast! ROOT BEER FLOAT SOCIAL AND A SPECIAL CAUSE...

The annual tradition of the FRA serving up Root Beer Floats in combination with the Foothills Community Church BBQ will occur on Thursday, June 28th at 5:30 PM at the FRA Community Center. This event is always one of the highlights of the summer season here in the Foothills. The FRA traditionally seeks donations for the annual scholarship funds at this event, but this year will be a little different. Contributions and donations will be accepted for Van Jacobson, a long-time Foothills resident who was recently seriously injured while working on his property.

Van Jacobson is the eldest son of Herb and Marie Jacobson. His family moved to the Foothills of Spokane, Washington from the Dishman area when he was 10 years old. He has lived in the Foothills for the past 65 years. It was a farming family and they specialized in Kentucky Bluegrass crops. Van took over the farming from his father and also dabbled in cabbage farming. He went to school and became a registered land surveyor. He has continued doing that occupation up to the present day. Van loves the forest and has lived many days in "Smokey's Gym". He graduated from West Valley High School in 1960, but his East Valley children don't hold that against him. Recently, Van was out cleaning up some slash piles in preparation for spring clean up around the homestead. A horrendous accident occurred, leaving his body with 30% surface area of 3rd degree burns on his lower half. He was flown to Harborview Hospital in Seattle on the 22nd of April. He is still there in the Burn ICU and will be there a bit longer. He is undergoing extensive graft surgeries, in an attempt to salvage and repair the damage caused by the fire. His wife, Sandy, and her children are taking turns rotating over to visit and stay with him through this ordeal, and they are all trying to adjust to the new reality and severity of the accident and how it will affect all of their futures.

During the Root Beer Float Social in June the FRA will be collecting donations for Van's long recovery. Any contribution will be greatly appreciated.

FOOTHILLS SCENIC FIVE 2018

The FRA is once again hosting the Foothills Scenic Five Fun Run on July 21, 2018. The event is a 5-mile rolling hills course for runners or a less strenuous 3-mile course for runners and walkers. This is a beautiful scenic course with views of Mt. Spokane, local agriculture and possibly local wildlife. Additional information is located below.

Race Start: 8:00 a.m. • Late registration and packet pick up from 7:15-7:45 am

Where: Foothills Community Center 11003 N. Forker Rd. • Five miles north of Trent on Forker Rd., directly across from the Foothills Community Church and next to the fire station. (ALL WHITE BUILDINGS)



- Fill out and sign the entry form below. \$10 no shirt / \$20 with shirt. Race entry includes breakfast; additional breakfast tickets may be purchased for those not participating in the fun run. Age 5 & under free; shirt sold separately (sorry, no children's sizes available). Send payment to: Foothills Rural Association 7318 N. Adams Rd., Spokane, WA 99217.
- Pre-entry: entries must be post marked by July 7th to ensure shirt size selection. Day of race: some shirts may be available day of race; sizes will vary. Entry fees are non-refundable.

Awards ceremony: to begin approximately 15-minutes after the last finisher—including a special award for the overall male and female finisher in both the five- and three-mile race. Age group awards for the five-mile race only, followed by a random prize drawing for all race entrants. Must be present to receive award/prize.

General Info: This is an open course; expect vehicle traffic on the route. No dogs or headphones, please. There will be an all you can eat huckleberry pancake breakfast from 8:30-11:00 a.m. in the Community Center. Come and enjoy a hot meal! The cost will be \$5.00 for those not entered in the fun run; children 5 and under eat & "race" for free (shirt not included). Those not entered in the race may pay for breakfast at the door. This fun run is co-hosted by Foothills Rural Association (501c4 nonprofit) and the EVHS girls cross country team, who will split the proceeds from this annual fundraiser.


FRA MEMBERSHIP & DUES 2018

The Foothills Rural Association, 11000 N. Forker Road, was established as a non-profit corporation under section 502(c)4 of the Internal Revenue Code on December 12, 1983. The purposes of the corporation are to organize the property owners and/or current residents within the boundaries of Fire District 9 Station 6 to provide a forum by which the property owners and/or current residents can assist governmental agencies in better planning the use and resources of the Foothills area; and to preserve and protect the rural agricultural environment.

Voting Membership in the Association is open to any property owner or current resident within the Foothills boundaries. Membership dues are \$20 per year. Non-voting Membership is available to others through payment of dues. The Association is governed by elected volunteer officers and a board of directors.

FRA Alerts system has been established in an effort to increase community awareness about crime occurring in our area. Residents are encouraged to report ALL crimes to Crime Check, 456-2233. The Foothills Community Center, 11000 N. Forker Road, which is located adjacent to the Foothills Fire Station, exists as a result of community efforts to save and renovate the former Foothills School Building. The Center, used for many community activities, is maintained and supported by the Foothills Rural Association. It is available for use by members of the Foothills Rural Association for a nominal utilities charge and by non-members for a reasonable rental fee. 
