The quaint building was the localized meeting place for the women's group, the Blue-Ribbon Circle when the membership dues were just ten cents and is the current location of the monthly Foothills Rural Association meetings. The Foothills Rural Association, or FRA, act as the stewards of the property and continue to rent out the center to both local residents and those outside of the district 9 boundaries.
